#### **Fund Description**

The VanEck International High Yield Bond ETF (IHY<sup>®</sup>) seeks to replicate as closely as possible, before fees and expenses, the price and yield performance of the ICE BofA Global ex-US Issuers High Yield Constrained Index (HXUS), which is comprised of U.S. dollar, Canadian dollar, pound sterling, and euro denominated below investment grade corporate bonds issued by non-U.S. corporations in the major domestic or Eurobond markets.
