

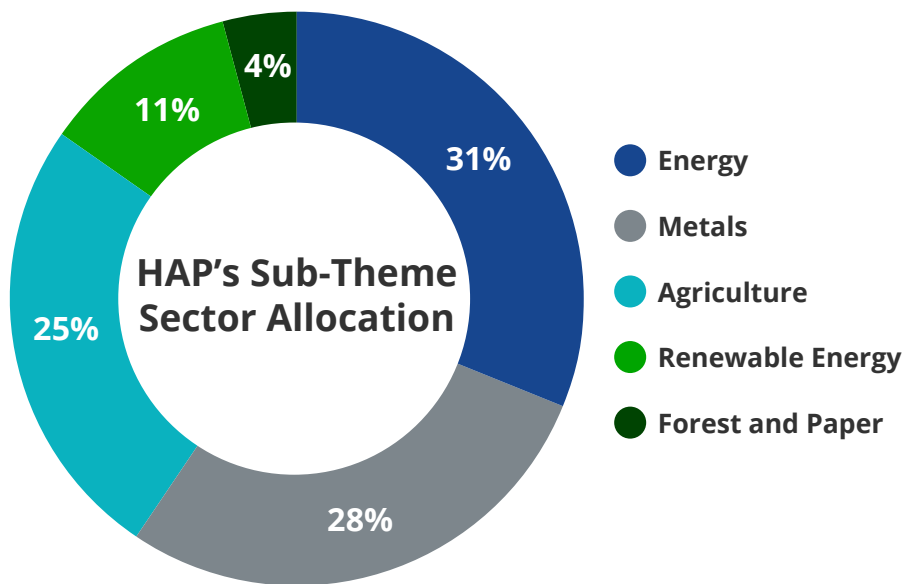

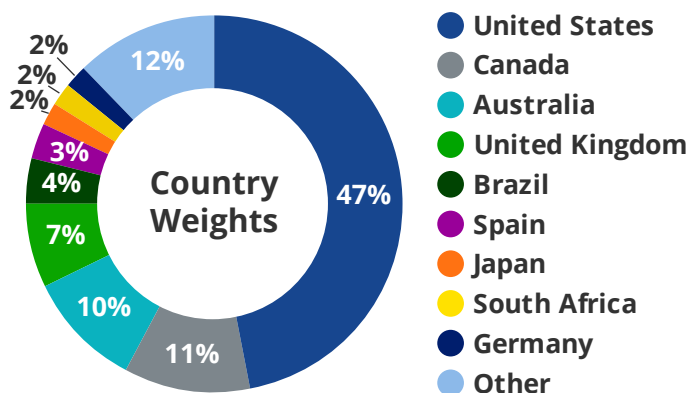
Why HAP?
